**H.Res. \_\_** - Rule providing for consideration of H.R. 1375 - Financial Services Regulatory Relief Act  
(Sponsored by Rep. Sessions / Rules Committee)

**Rolled Suspension Votes** (2 bills):

- 1) **H.R. 3782** - Counter-Terrorist and Narco-Terrorist Rewards Program Act  
(Sponsored by Rep. Hyde / International Relations Committee)
