(Sponsored by Rep. Hastings (WA) / Rules Committee)

H.Con.Res. 393 - Concurrent Resolution on the Budget for FY 2005
(Structured Rule, Complete Consideration) (Sponsored by Rep. Nussle / Budget Committee)
