Suspensions (5 bills):

- 1) **H.R. 912** - Charles `Pete' Conrad Astronomy Awards Act (*Sponsored by Rep. Rohrabacher / Science Committee*)
- 2) **H.R. 3389** - To amend the Stevenson-Wydler Technology Innovation Act of 1980 to permit Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Awards to be made to nonprofit organizations (*Sponsored by Rep. Miller (NC) / Science Committee*)
- 3) **H.R. 1417** - Copyright Royalty and Distribution Reform Act of 2003 (*Sponsored by Rep. Smith (TX) / Judiciary Committee*)
- 4) **H.Res. 412** - Honoring the men and women of the Drug Enforcement Administration on the occasion of its 30th Anniversary (*Sponsored by Rep. Souder / Judiciary Committee*)
- 5) **H.Res. 56** - Supporting the goals of the Japanese American, German American, and Italian American communities in recognizing a National Day of Remembrance to increase public awareness of the events surrounding the restriction, exclusion, and internment of individuals and families during World War II (*Sponsored by Rep. Honda / Judiciary Committee*)

H.R. 1561 - United States Patent and Trademark Fee Modernization Act of 2003 (Structured Rule)
