On Thursday, the House will meet at 9:00 a.m. and recess immediately to prepare the House Chamber for a Joint Meeting of Congress. The House will reconvene at 10:00 a.m. in a Joint Meeting with the Senate for the purpose of receiving His Excellency Ayad Allawi, Interim Prime Minister of the Republic of Iraq.
Last votes expected: Late Afternoon.
